STRESSLESS means no need to plait, neat, safe dress but jackets not compulsory **Friendly atmosphere, suitable for novice combinations. If you have experience at one level, why not take the opportunity to try a step up to the next in relaxing surroundings.

RULES Event will be run under BRC Rules, adapted as necessary.

HATS Hard Hats to the minimum BRC standard must be worn at all times when mounted.

LIABILITY The organisers and all persons connected with the event are not responsible for any accident, injury, damage or any other loss to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other persons or property.

COVID 19 – Stressless Dressage Competitions.

Welton and District Riding Club are delighted to be able to hold our dressage events and whilst restrictions are constantly changing please take time to read through the requirements below. This forms part of our risk assessment in order to be able to go ahead with competitions.

- Please do not attend if you or anyone in your household has been unwell or showing any symptoms;
- As a condition of entry, if you are a non WDRC member you must complete a declaration form which can be found on the WDRC website and should be emailed to the club at weltondrc@yahoo.co.uk. This is in order to fulfil our obligations in respect of track and trace;
- Do not arrive at the venue more than 60 minutes before your allocated dressage time. You will be able to have approximately 40 minutes to warm up and six horses/ponies will be allowed in the warm up area at any one time. If two arenas are running, there will be two warm up areas;
- Once you have completed your test(s) please leave the venue as soon as possible;
- Each rider may bring up to 5 helpers from not more than 2 households. Social distancing (2m if possible) is recommended for everyone attending;
- Please ensure that if you use any communal areas and open/close gates into the venue or arena you use the hand sanitizer available ;
- Follow all instructions given by the organiser and stewards in relation to where vehicles should be parked and ensure that vehicles are parked at least 3 metres apart;
- Please avoid using the toilet if possible;
- Horses and ponies must not be tied up unattended outside of lorries and trailers;
- Dogs must be kept in your vehicle or on a short lead at all times.
