IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING QUALIFIER ENTRY FEES

The fees for all Area Qualifiers come in two payment parts. The first payment is a "preliminary fee" which the Club have to pay to British Riding Clubs Head Office (BRC) to declare the intention of an entry. Once this has been paid, the Club will then have to pay the "Area" entry fee, at the same time as putting forward names of riders and horses to Area 16. For instance, the prelim fee for an individual DR/SJ qualifier is currently £11.00 and the Area entry fee is £17.50, making a total of £28.50.

However, due to the success of the events we have recently hosted, this year the Committee have taken the decision to allow the Club to pay the Preliminary Entry fees for the Area 16 qualifiers. This means that those who put their names forward for the teams or as individuals will only be asked to pay for the Area entry fee.

** Please note therefore that payment of entry fees must be paid **before** the close of the prelim entries so that we can add you to the prelim entry. Once WDRC pays the preliminary entry to BRC, we then have to pay the equivalent Area entry, whether the rider pays/competes or not, and the Club lose this money as it is not refunded.**

There is an opportunity to pay late prelim fees, but this costs an additional £10, which we would hope to avoid.
